### Miscellaneous Information

- Streaming** All games will be streamed *free* via <https://ncll.godogsports.com/>
- Concessions** Concession stand offers hot dogs, chicken tenders, french fries, mozzarella sticks, pretzels, chips, candy, ice cream, soda, Gatorade, water.
- Umpires** We will be using Lower Hudson Valley and RCUA Umpire Associations. We will have two umpires per game. Qualified umpires are selected and approved by the District Administrator, Tournament Director, and League President
- Uniforms** Must follow Little League standards
- Format** Pool Play and Single Elimination or Double Elimination Tournament (dependent on final team count)
- Code of Conduct** The action of managers, coaches, and spectators must be exemplary at all times. No profanity or unsportsmanlike conduct by any manager, coach, player or spectator will not be tolerated. Absolutely NO ALCOHOL will be allowed at the park before, during or after games. This includes the parking lot and any other area within the facility.
- Batting Cage** We have two batting cages available for practices and before games. Please be courteous and limit your time in the cages, so that every team can have adequate time to warm up.
- Practices** Strawtown 1 will be utilized for practice. **No team is permitted to practice on Strawtown 2 at any time.** A practice schedule will be available at the Manager's Meeting. Teams will be permitted to practice in the morning and afternoon ahead of each day's games.
- Parking** We have ample parking in the center of the facility.
- Park Hours** We will be at the park approximately two hours prior to the first games of the day to open the bathrooms and prepare for the days games. We will open earlier if any team would like access to the practice field and / or batting cages.
